## Water Use Information You Need to Know

The Village of Royal Palm Beach's potable water supply is provided by Palm Beach County Utilities following the sale of our water utility to Palm Beach County in April 2006. Pursuant to the sale agreement, our water and sewer use rates were frozen for a ten year period that expires this year. Starting on October 1, 2016 our water rates will be adjusted to be consistent with the rest of the County's customers. Options are now available to pay your water bill by registering with a credit card through <http://www.pbcgov.com/waterutilities/>. Given that this transition will likely increase your current water and sewer cost, the following is a summary of information to help you and your family conserve water and save money.

## Water Conservation

Water conservation is easy and makes sense! Conservation begins with understanding your day-to-day water use demands. Through some simple adjustments you can gain immediate cost savings in both water and energy uses. Here are the areas for you to focus on with links for more information.

### Indoors

How can I save water in my home? The South Florida Water Management District Conservation webpage includes tools and information to help you. Contact the SFWMD at 1-800-662-8876 or visit [www.sfwmd.gov/conserv](http://www.sfwmd.gov/conserv).

Here are examples of ways to save.

Replace older toilets with WaterSense toilets - that could save a family of four more than \$90 annually on its water utility bill, and \$2,000 over the lifetime of the toilets. Repair dripping faucets. One drop per second wastes 2,700 gallons of water per year!

Don't run the water when brushing your teeth.

Install aerators or replace the entire faucet to increase the efficiency by 30 percent - without sacrificing performance.

Wash only full loads of dishes and clothes or lower the water settings for smaller loads. Replace your old washing machine with a high-efficiency, ENERGY STAR® labeled model, which uses up to 50 percent less water and electricity.

### Outdoors

Water used on our landscapes can account for 50% of our household water usage. Here are some key links on how to save on irrigation costs. In Florida, landscaping in a 'Florida-Friendly' way means using low maintenance plants and environmentally sustainable practices. Once established, native landscaping does not need water as frequently and usually will survive a dry period without watering. They also require less fertilizer and herbicides.

Raising the lawn mower blade to at least three inches or to its highest level encourages grass roots to grow deeper, shades the root system and holds soil moisture.

Year-round irrigation measures are in place for Palm Beach County and its municipalities. Water only when needed and check your irrigation systems regularly.

Install an irrigation well in lieu of using drinking water from Palm Beach County Utilities.




