RECENT CODE CHANGES

At the November 17, 2016 Council Meeting, amendments to the Village of Royal Palm Beach Municipal Code Chapter 14 "Junked and Abandoned Vehicles" and Chapter 23 "Traffic and Vehicles" were approved. The following are summations of the Code changes. The Code in its entirety can be viewed at www.royalpalmbeach.com. The changes to Chapter 14 expanded the definition of Junked or Abandoned vehicles, cars, RV's and boats to now include rusted, inoperable and dismantled vehicles and are not to be stored for a period of 30 days or more.

The changes to Chapter 23 are as follows:

Clarification that just as (1) boat maximum is allowed on a single family property, (1) RV maximum is also allowed on the same single family lot .

Cars, Boats and RV's shall be parked in an orientation which is similar in direction to the design of the driveway as related to the structure. For example, most driveways are perpendicular to the roadway, thus vehicles shall be parked in the same orientation. Curved and circular drives will also follow orientation of the drive.

Boats and RV's parked in any area of the front yard shall be parked at a minimum of 15' offset from the edge of roadway pavement or owner's property side rear edge of sidewalk.

The amendments relating to the distance an RV or boat must be parked from the edge of roadway pavement and the number of RV's permitted to be parked on each single family property shall be effective on June 1, 2017. All other amendments to this section shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

News from PBSO District 9 . . . The safety of you and your family is of the utmost importance to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office. That is why it is very important for you as the parent or guardian of a child to know how to start a dialogue with them about what to do if they find a gun. The following is suggested language provided by the National Crime Prevention Council for talking to your kids about firearms.

Talking To Your Children...

An accident involving a gun can hurt or even kill you or someone you know. Most adults are allowed to own a gun by law and many have one. This means that even if there isn't a gun in your house, you need to know what to do if you see a gun. If you see a gun anywhere, for example, in the park by your house, follow these four steps: **1. Stop. 2. Don't touch. 3. Get away. 4. Tell an adult.** When you follow these steps, you are protecting yourself and helping to keep other people safe. Here are some tips about what to do in specific circumstances:

- Walk away and tell a parent if your friend shows you his parent's gun.
- Tell an adult immediately if you see a gun in someone's backpack at school.
- Tell a trusted adult if you hear a girl or boy say that she or he is going to bring a gun to school.

The Center to Prevent Youth Violence has created a resource for parents who want to inquire if there are firearms where their children play. The ASK campaign, created in collaboration with the American Academy of Pediatrics suggests it may be easier to open the dialogue by following these four tips.

ASK with other questions. Include the question along with other things you might normally discuss before sending your child to someone's house –such as seat belts, animals or allergies. **Use the facts.** Over one-third of homes with children have a gun. Many of those guns are left unlocked and loaded. That is why you are asking — you just want to make sure that your child is safe. **Work through groups.** Introduce the ASK concept through a group or community effort such as a religious organization or PTA. **Don't be confrontational.** Present your concerns in a respectful manner. You are simply trying to make sure your child is in a safe environment. Use the ASK brochure to open the dialogue.





FYI..... How to Safeguard Your Home

- Do not list your first name in the telephone book. Instead use initials.
- Make sure your answering machine message does not indicate that you are alone.
- Have deadbolts installed on all doors. Keep doors and windows locked.
- Install a peep-hole on your door. Never open the door to strangers.
- Keep blinds closed at night to discourage "Peeping Toms."
- Do not hang lingerie outdoors.
- Verify the identity of any repairmen by the telephone number listed in the phone book, not on their identification.
- If someone comes to your door asking to use the telephone, make the call yourself. Do not invite them in.
- Do not hide a spare key under the door mat or under a flower pot. Thieves know all the good hiding places.
- Plant thorny bushes under all windows. Invest in motion sensor lights and a good security system.
- Get a barking dog or "beware of dog" signs.
- Always double check doors at night and lock all windows.
- Be sure your garage door can be secured. Do not leave it open when you are away; an empty garage broadcasts your absence.
